Venue Information

CFC22 will take place from Tuesday 9 August 2022 to Saturday 20 August 2022 at the University of East London SportsDock campus:

The University of East London (UEL) SportsDock facility is a large multi-purpose sports complex including two connected sports halls, and several meeting rooms. UEL hosted team USA before and during the 2012 London Olympic Games and has hosted, for several years, the British Senior Championships, the British Cadet & Junior Championships, the Eden Cup (the UK's Under-20 World Cup), and the Leon Paul Satellite.

UEL SportsDock is also home to the local fencing club Newham Swords, a community foil fencing club with international success coached by Olympians Pierre Harper and Linda Strachan.

There is a small cafe on site with a seated eating area just outside the main sports hall. It has a limited range of hot and cold refreshments, so please be prepared to queue. The cafe operates <u>cashless</u>, meaning that only card payments are accepted. In the UK, contactless card payments are accepted up to a value of £100 (GBP).

CFC22 recommends that fencers and spectators make use of the nearby superstores to stock up on supplies.













Accessibility

The venue is fully accessible via a second main entrance next to reception. The secondary main entrance is reached via a moderate, permanent slope.

Parking is free at all times for blue-badge holders.

Parking

Parking is pay-and-display. CFC22 has obtained free parking for weekend days (Saturdays and Sundays) only. Parking is free to blue-badge holders at all times.

It is recommended that fencers and spectators travel to the venue by public transport where possible.

Transport Options

CF	C22 is readily accessible from several international airports:
	☐ London City Airport - less than 15 minutes by public transport

Connections are also available to London Luton and London Southend airports.

The nearest accessible public rail station is Cyprus DLR. Cyprus DLR station is a 5-7 minute walk from the venue.

<u>Transport For London</u> manages all public transport in London, and the website provides a journey planner, fare information and live status update.

Weapons Control

Weapons control will open on Monday 8 August 2022 at 1pm.

For Senior, Wheelchair, Junior and Cadet events, team managers will be given a time slot one day before each event to present equipment to weapons control. Only the team manager will be able to submit equipment to weapons control for Senior, Wheelchair, Junior and Cadet events.

For Veteran events, each entrant will be given a time slot one day before their event to present equipment to weapons control.

For example if a fencer is due to compete in an individual event on Monday 15 August, they will be able to submit their equipment to weapons control only the day before on Sunday 14 August. They will not be required to re-submit their equipment before their team event.

If resubmissions are required, the team manager of the fencer, and/or the fencer themself, will be notified of a time slot in which they can resubmit their equipment.

Each fencer will be required to submit:

One (1) mask
One (1) lame vest (i.e., metallic vest) for Foil and Sabre
One (1) glove
Between two (2) and four (4) weapons
Between two (2) and four (4) body wires
Between two (2) and three (3) mask wires for Foil and Sabre

Repairs

CFC22 will not be offering a repair service to competitors. Replacement equipment will be available for purchase, however, it is recommended that fencers and/or teams bring













sufficient supplies to carry out necessary repairs, so please ensure you (and your athletes) bring appropriate replacement/ repair kit with them.

On the top floor there is an open air cinema with tasty street food booths, which is a very quirky alternative evening.
- There are many <u>convenience mini-supermarkets</u> near the venue, for snacks, drinks and other essential supplies, these are within a short walking distance of Sports Dock.

Visa Entry Requirements

It is the responsibility of the individual athletes and team managers to ensure that the appropriate entry visa is applied for if required.

CFC22 understands that for the vast majority of visitors from Commonwealth nations, visas will not be required for entry to the UK. Nonetheless, some Commonwealth nationals do require a visa to enter the UK.

It is the responsibility of each fencer/spectator to ensure that they have complied with the Visa Entry requirements.

A list of countries whose nationals require a visa to enter the UK can be found here.

CFC22 understands that if a visa is required, a Standard UK Visitor Visa will be sufficient. More details about the Standard UK Visitor Visa can be found here, to apply this link can be used.

As part of your online application, you may need to book an appointment at a visa application centre. Please allow time to attend your appointment, as the <u>visa application</u> <u>centre</u> could be in another country.

- At your appointment, you'll need to prove your identity with your passport or travel document
- have your fingerprints and photograph (known as 'biometric information') taken













• provide the required documents that show you're eligible for a Standard Visitor visa

The visa application centre may keep your passport and documents while processing your application.

The average turnaround time for UK Standard Visitor Visa applications is 3 weeks. However, we recommend applying for the Visa as soon as allowable in case of delays.

Covid-19 Protocols

CFC22 is, of course, mindful of the constantly evolving situation regarding the Covid-19 pandemic.

While, at the time of writing, the UK government has lifted all Covid-19 restrictions in England, a number of guidelines are still in place. Additionally, we will be putting in place protocols to mitigate the risk of Covid-19 transmission at the event that will comply with, and may exceed, government guidelines.

Due to the changing nature of Covid-19 guidelines, we have not finalised the protocols. Protocols will be finalised and published on <u>1 August 2022</u>.

However, we advise fencers/spectators to expect that some combination of proof-of-vaccination status, negative PCR test-result and/or negative lateral-flow test is likely to be required and standard social distancing measures, including the wearing of face masks is likely to be mandatory.
