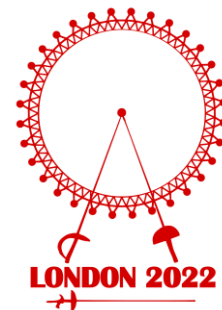


2022 Commonwealth Fencing Championships (Open, Veteran,
Wheelchair, Junior, and Cadet)



Information Bulletin No. 5

7th September 2021

This information bulletin serves to open the entry window for the 2022, Cadet, Junior, Senior & Veteran Commonwealth (able & wheelchair) Fencing Championships.

1. Entries are Open!

The entry fees for CFC22 are as follows:

Individual events (all categories): £70 + £25 referee levy = £95
Team championship events (all categories): £200 + £75 referee levy = £275
Team challenge (ie secondary/ancillary team events) = £108

For individual veteran entries, we offer a modest multi-weapon discount according to the following schedule:

1 weapon entry = £95
2 weapon entry = £185
3 weapon entry = £275

Entries must be made via the nominated contact for each member country.

The only exception to this is veteran fencers from a Commonwealth nation that falls under the umbrella of British Fencing. They can enter directly via the entry form on the event website.

Countries may enter up to 5 fencers into each individual event and only one team (3 or 4 fencers) in each championship event. All competitors must have an FIE or IWAS licence as appropriate.

Entries for the individual and team championship events close on 9 June 2022. When entering teams, it is not necessary to register the names at the time of entry. The names of the fencers competing in each team event must be registered with DT by 10am the day before said event.

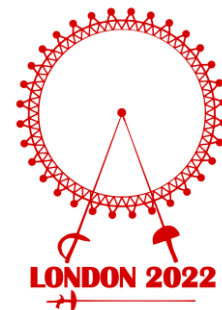
Entries for the team challenge may be capped subject to space and timetabling restrictions and must be completed by 11am on the day before the respective event.

Monthly invoices will be raised to each country and entries will not be confirmed until payment has been received.

2. Contact Details:

Please can participating countries send the names and contact details of their "nominated contact" to the competition email address listed with the details listed below. The nominated contact will be the intermediary between the event and the athletes/NGBs and may be a different person for the senior and veteran events.
